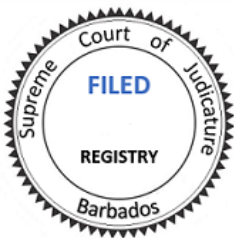


**AND UPON DETERMINING** that this matter be deemed fit for an urgent hearing;

**AND UPON HEARING MS. TREANN KNIGHT**, State Counsel (Ag) and Attorney-at-Law for the Claimant;

**IT IS HEREBY ORDERED:**

- i. that Order **CV 1448 of 2019** dated the 13<sup>th</sup> day of November 2019 be varied as a matter of urgency to have the Defendant removed from the list of persons designated as terrorists under section 8 (4) of the Anti-Terrorism (Amendment) Act, 2019-34;
- ii. that any property which was restrained by the Order **CV 1448 of 2019** dated the 13<sup>th</sup> day of November 2019, whether wholly or jointly owned or controlled, directly or indirectly, by the Defendant, be restored;
- iii. that the Registrar of the Supreme Court serve a copy of the Order on the Financial Intelligence Unit (FIU) immediately;
- iv. that the Court dispense with service on the Defendant;
- v. that pursuant to **section 10(1)** of the Act, the Director of Public Prosecutions cause a copy of the Order, to be published electronically immediately and in the Official Gazette and in at least two (2) daily newspapers in circulation in Barbados, as soon as possible.
- vi. costs to be costs in the cause;
- vii. all such further Orders and/or directions as the Court deems fit for securing and enforcing the Declaratory Order sought in the circumstances of the case; and

viii. liberty to apply.
